Inside any KSC building you will not need a user name and password. When using at home, you will be asked for a username and password. All databases use the same username and password.

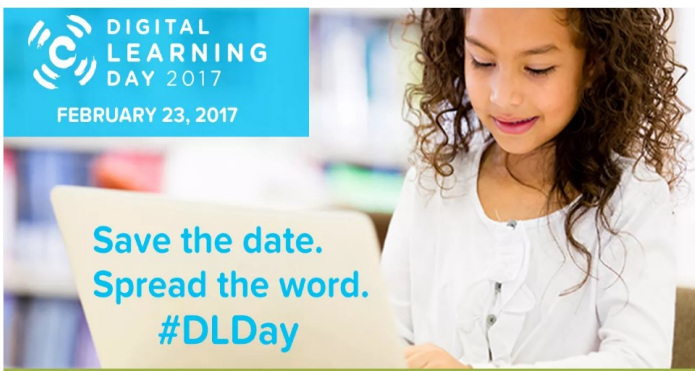
