Outlook Tip: How to Automatically Send a Particular Sender’s E-mail Directly to Trash

There are times you may provide your email to a vendor at a conference, or perhaps there is an online subscription you signed up for, and the vendor/company were happy to share your email address to similar companies. In cases such as these, your inbox may start becoming inundated with emails and offers you do not want, and you really don’t have time to deal with. How can you send these emails straight to the trash without even coming to your inbox?

In your Inbox, from the e-mail you no longer want to come into your inbox:

- Right click
- Go down to “Junk”
- Next to the small arrow is a dropdown
- Click on “Block Sender”
- Anything that sender/advertiser will automatically be sent to your trash in outlook and you will not even see these annoying offers/information
