

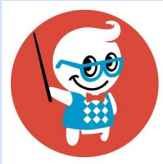


## Google Releases Goal Tool for Google Calendar

## Changes to Canvas User Interface Reminder

Just a reminder: starting in July 2016, Canvas' New User Interface will include two main components: the Dashboard and Global Navigation Menu.

The Dashboard defaults to the course view, which provides access and updates to courses. The Dashboard course view includes a sidebar with To Do and Coming Up lists to help manage assignments. It also includes a Recent Feedback stream that shows activity for all your Canvas courses.

The Global Navigation Menu provides quick links to all main Canvas content areas. Users can receive help in Canvas by clicking the Help icon located at the bottom of the Global Navigation Menu.
